PARTS

- Ice Shaver Unit

OPTIONAL ITEMS

- Heavy Duty Extension Cord (10-12 Gauge / 50' or Less)
- Large Bowl
- Block(s) of Ice
- Snowcone Syrup
 - Blueberry
 - Blue Raspberry
 - Bubble Gum
 - Cherry
 - Grape
 - Lime
 - Orange
 - Raspberry
 - Tigers Blood
- Snowcone Cups (6 oz)
- Spoons

REQUIREMENTS

- 120 Volt / 7.5 Amps Power Source
- Level Table / Surface

CLEAN-UP

- Unplug unit from the power source.
- Remove any remaining ice.
- Wipe away any water.

OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Allow ice to soften to create clear non-frosted ice.
2. Place Ice Shaver on a sturdy / level table.
3. Plug the unit into a power source. (Must be within 50')
4. At this time the motor will run, but the drive chain will not.
5. Switch the toggle to the reverse position and retract the drive chain to lower the pressure plate.
6. Open the front door and place block of ice on the drive chain track.
7. Put the toggle switch in the forward position and advance block of ice to close the door.
8. Close the door.
9. Push the drive chain button and hold to drive the block into the ice shaver blade.
10. Stop by releasing the button.
11. Scoop ice, top with syrup(s) and serve.

SERVINGS PER BLOCK OF ICE (8 oz. serving)

- Estimate 1/3 - 1/2 pound of ice per cone
- 10 pound block of ice = 20 - 30 servings

HELPFUL HINTS

Do something special and consider adding the following items to your shaved ice to make them something special!

- Condensed Milk or Coconut Milk
- Fresh Fruits
- Chocolate Syrup
- Vanilla Ice Cream
